From 18 - 21 May 2010 the Julius Center is organising an International Masterclass in Primary and Integrated Care in London, for a maximum of 40 managers and experienced professionals.

The Masterclass is being organised in collaboration with The King's Fund Centre, which is located in the centre of London, close to Oxford Circus and Regent Street. This centre holds a leading position in the UK in connection with education and research in the field of primary care innovation.
